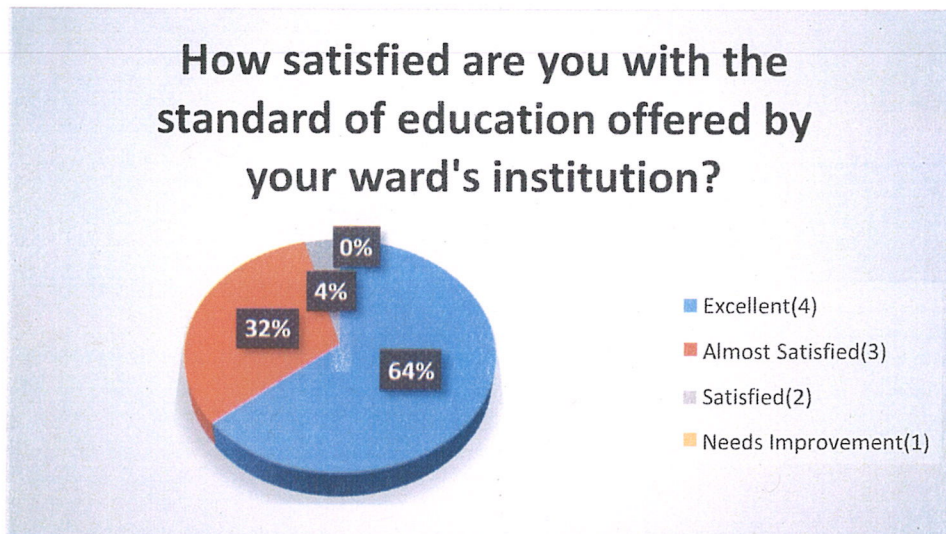


IMPACT ANALYSIS OF PARENT FEEDBACK

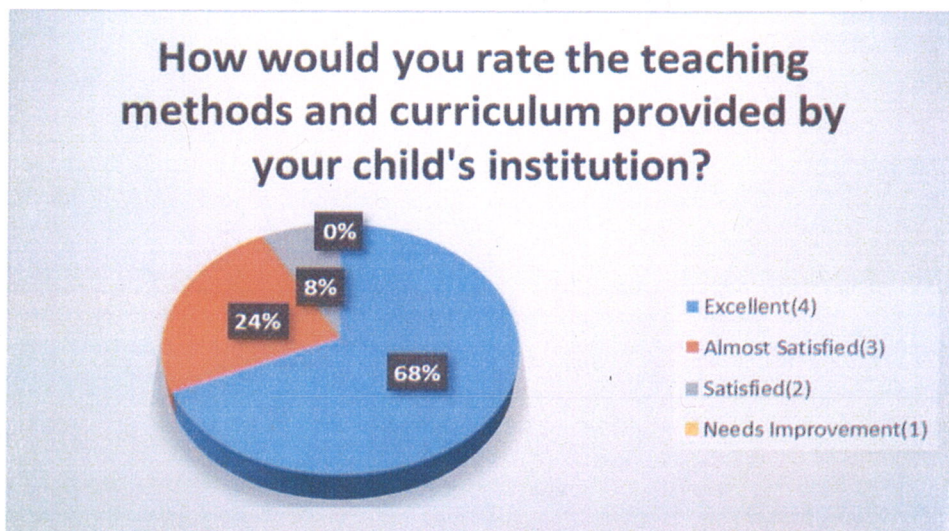
ACADEMIC YEAR: 2019 - 2020

Feedback from the Parents on academic curriculum and facilities of the institution was taken using a questionnaire to measure the following on a four-point Likert scale with the options of Excellent, Almost Satisfied, Satisfied and Needs Improvement. This survey is being conducted to determine the degree of parent satisfaction with the curriculum and facilities.

1 64% of Parents found standard of education offered by the wards's institution as excellent, 32% found it Almost Satisfied, 4% found it Satisfied and 0% rated it for Needs Improvement.

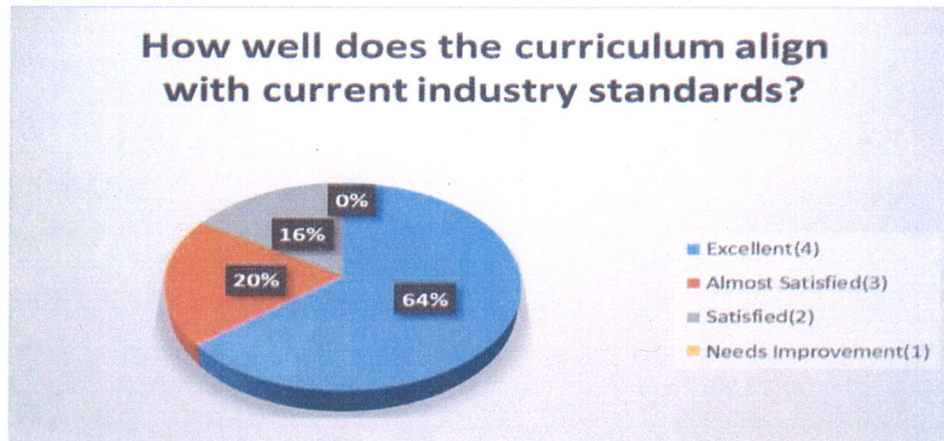

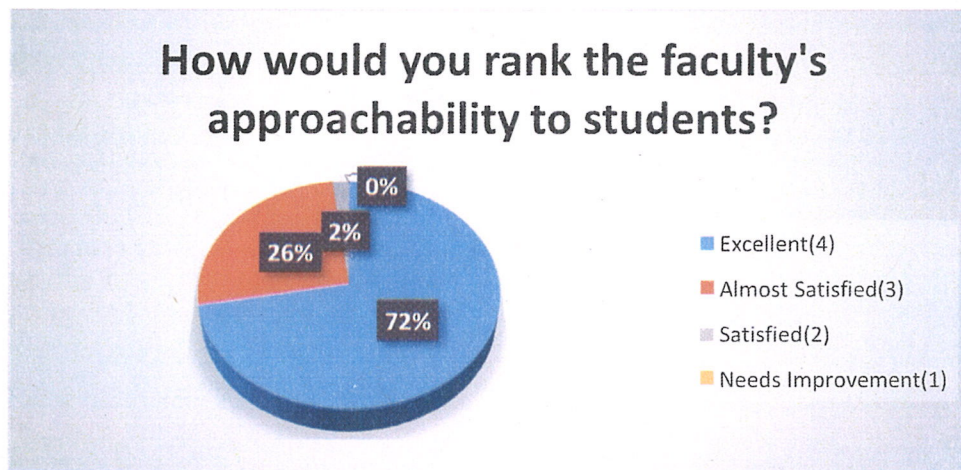

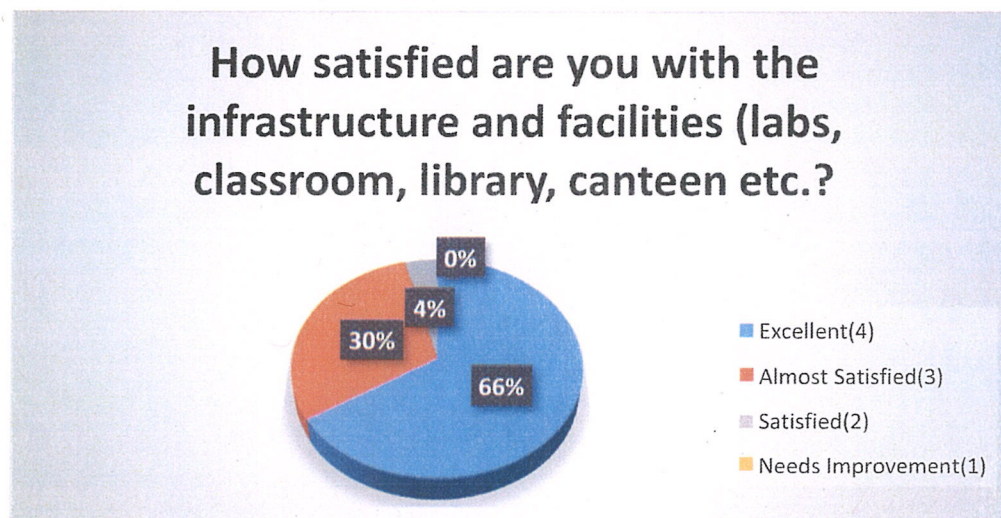

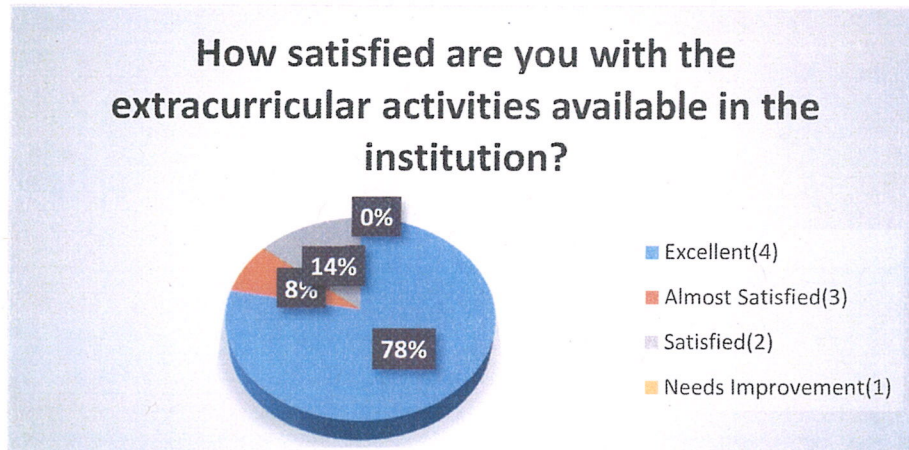

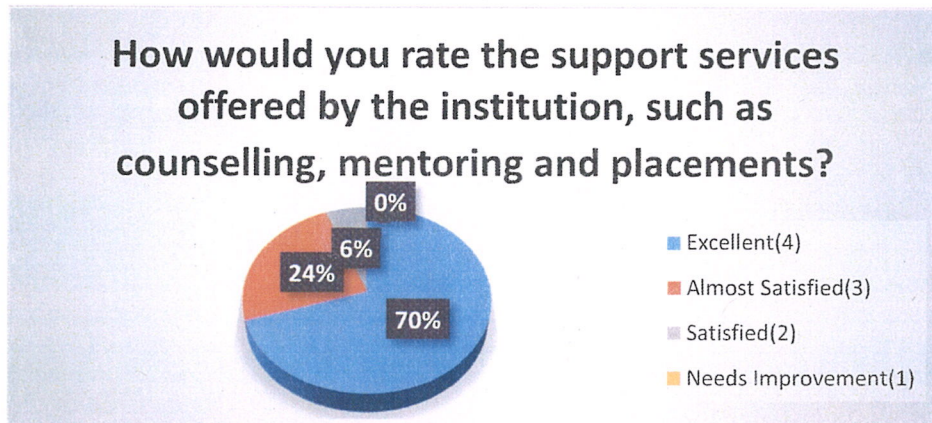
