



The SELECT FROM-WHERE Structure of basic SQL Queries

The basic form of the SELECT statement called mapping or SELECT FROM-WHERE block:

```
SELECT column_name(s)
FROM table_name
WHERE condition;
```


Where:

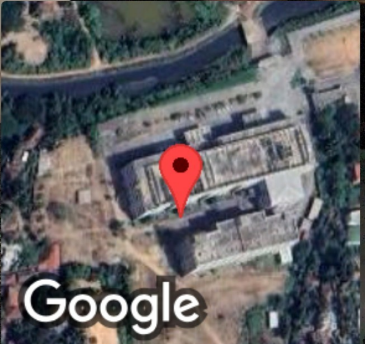
- column_name(s) - It is a list of attributes whose values are to be retrieved by the query. To specify multiple columns, use a comma and a space (',' and ' ') as separator.
- table_name - To retrieve all columns, use the table name (table_name).
- condition - It is a set of one or more criteria to be queried. Use a comma and space between table names when specifying multiple tables and logical operators to combine the expressions that describe the logic to be retrieved by the query.

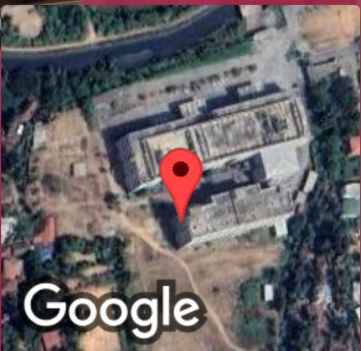
