Effective leaders are often distinguished by their ability to listen and respond thoughtfully, which enhances their decision-making and problem-solving abilities.

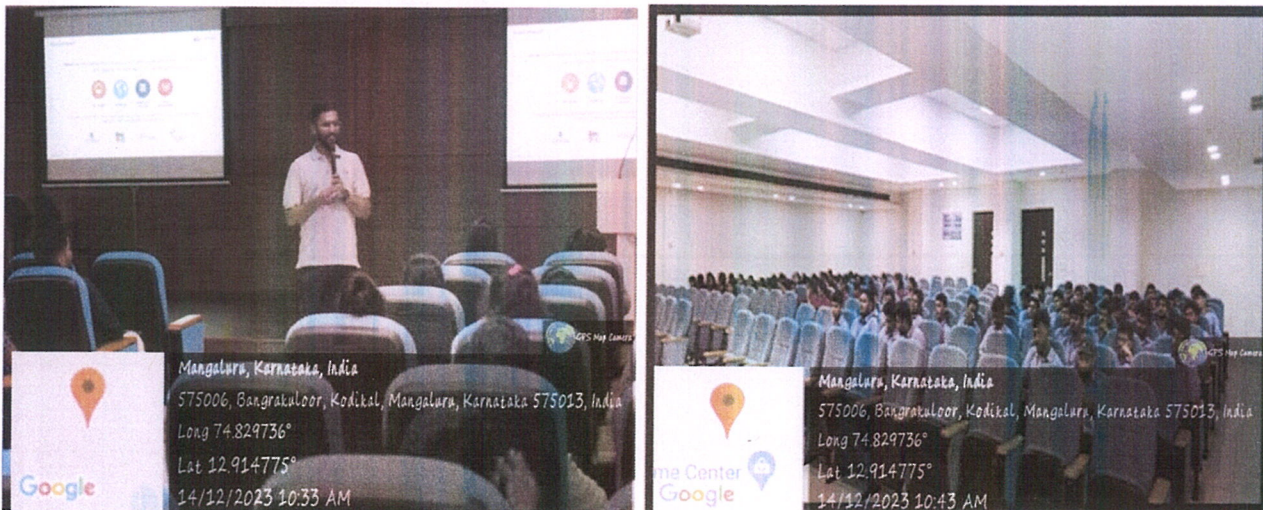
