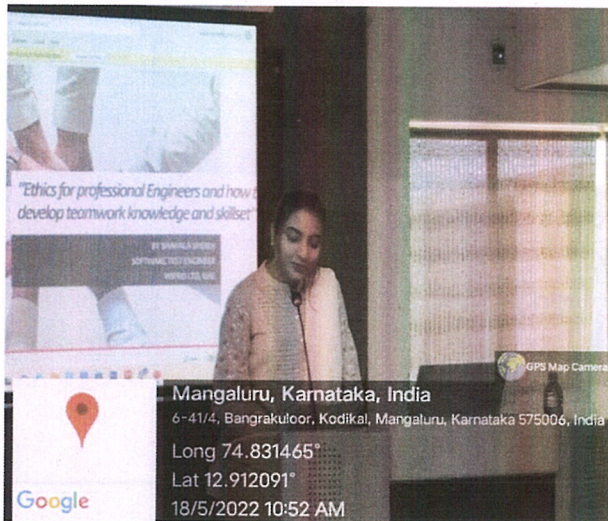
• Developing Teamwork Skills:
