

Sir/Madam,

As part of UGC's initiative towards reduction of compliance burden of its stakeholders, UGC has revised the procedure for students to file online Anti Ragging undertaking. Now the procedure is completely online and student is not required to submit any hard/printed affidavit in institute.

This procedure has been changed with the view to conserve paper, to protect our environment and to reduce compliance burden of our stakeholders.

It has been observed that some prominent institutions are still following the previous exercise. You are therefore requested to adopt the revised procedure and not to receive any hard/ printed affidavit by students.

Anti-Ragging Undertaking must be filled by the students online on <http://www.antiragging.in> only. Universities/Colleges will not accept Anti Ragging Undertaking by students in Hard/Printed copy/Affidavits. (Please note that the student is not required to print & sign it as it used to be in the earlier case).

Further the compliance submission is not upto the mark by the institutions, therefore you are also requested to submit compliance on the following link:

Respected Madam/Sir,

In pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, to exercise the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the UGC notified "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009". The Regulations are available on the UGC website www.ugc.gov.in & www.antiragging.in.

It is once again brought to your kind notice that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has framed regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. These regulations are mandatory, and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in Toto including the monitoring mechanism. Any violation of these regulations will be viewed seriously. If any institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or does not act in accordance with these Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, it will attract punitive action against itself by the UGC.

You are requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums; constitution of Anti-Ragging committee and Anti-Ragging squad, setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, Anti-Ragging workshops and seminar, updating all websites with nodal officers' complete details, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers and mention of Anti-Ragging warning in the institution's E-prospectus and E-information booklets/brochures must be ensured. Surprise inspection of hostels, students' accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, bus-stands must be carried out & Anti-Ragging posters must be displayed at all prominent places like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, Common facilities etc. These posters are available on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in. The size of the posters should be 8x6 feet. Any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled-for behavior/incident must be undertaken.

In compliance to the directions of the Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee constituted by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, HEIs/Councils have to implement the following:

1. The concept of mentor-mentee as given out in the UGC Regulations for curbing the Menace of Ragging in HEIs - 2009 be followed by students in all institutions to make a comfortable bond amongst Juniors and Seniors.
2. The Anti Ragging Cell and Anti Ragging Squads of institutions should be empowered by provisioning of a legal counsel so that airtight cases against the ragging culprits can be made.
3. Henceforth for extreme ragging and suicide cases, Principal of the college and Registrar of the University will be called and will be answerable to the National Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee for the reasons of non-compliance of UGC Regulations for ragging.
4. All the Councils/Regulatory Bodies must constitute a committee as and when a serious/suicide/death case is reported related to their Council/Regulatory Body to relook into the issue even when case is under police investigation. The Regulatory Bodies/Councils are also advised to appoint a legal person for the matter.
5. The Committee has also instructed the Anti Ragging Monitoring Agency to be more vigilant and carry out surprise checks all across the Nation to ensure that the UGC Regulations to curb the menace of ragging are being strictly adhered to by the HEI's, Teaching Staff and the students. Punitive action as mentioned in these regulations will be taken against the defaulters.

UGC also drives an Anti-Ragging Media Campaign through different modes and has undertaken the following activities to promote the campaign which are available on UGC website www.ugc.gov.in

1. UGC developed 05 TV Commercials of 30 seconds each with different perspective for Parents, Victim and Offenders.
2. UGC designed and distributed 04 types of posters amongst Universities / Regulatory Authorities / Councils / IITs / NITs / other educational institutions for their prominent display.
3. UGC consecutively organized 02 Anti-Ragging Competitions for students/faculty/general public for the wider awareness of the menace of ragging.

In compliance of the 2nd Amendment in UGC Regulations, you are requested to make it compulsory for each student and every parent to submit an online undertaking every academic year at www.antiragging.in

You are also requested to implement the revised procedure for students to file an online Anti-Ragging affidavit. The student will receive an e-mail with his/her registration number. The student will forward that e-mail to the Nodal officer in his/her university/college e-mail.

Universities/Colleges have to display the email address and contact number of the Nodal Officer of Anti-Ragging Committee of their university/college on their website and campus areas like Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, and Common facilities, etc.





Sub: Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Colleges under VTU - reg...

Ragging refers to an act that violates the dignity of a person. It is a matter of shame that even though ragging has been criticized for decades, we still come across such incidents of inhuman torture. As a result, many students give up their studies and go back home, some lose their mental balance, and some are seriously injured. The scourge of ragging which corrodes the vitals of our campuses needs to be curbed.

In this regard, it is brought to the notice of all the colleges, students and other stake holders that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC, AICTE & Government has framed regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions.

In this respect, the following are uploaded to VTU website www.vtu.ac.in

1. UGC Regulations , 2009
2. AICTE Regulations, 2009
3. AICTE & UGC Public Notices.
4. Karnataka State Govt. Circular
5. Responsibilities of Educational Institutions

As per the same, the Anti Ragging Committee and Anti Ragging Squads are to be constituted in the colleges and information about the same shall be given wide circulation about the same. The names of members of the committee with their contact numbers shall be uploaded to college website. The committees shall have to act vigilantly and take immediate needful action.

During admission of students, the affidavits avowing not to indulge in ragging (formats enclosed) by student and parent shall be obtained, without fail.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

1. Applicable to **ALL** higher educational institutions, imparting education beyond 12 years of schooling.

BEFORE AND DURING ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION :

2. **Every public declaration, brochure of admission/instruction booklet** or the prospectus to print these regulations in full.

3. **Telephone numbers** of the Anti-Ragging Helpline and all the important functionaries in the institution, members of the Anti-Ragging Committees and Anti-Ragging Squads etc. to be published in **brochure of admission/instruction booklet** or the prospectus/ uploaded in website.

4 Every student and his/her parents to file an **affidavit** avowing not to indulge in ragging.

5. The institution to prominently display posters detailing laws and punishment against ragging.

6. Anti-ragging squad to ensure **vigil at odd hours** during first few months at hostels, inside institution premises as well as privately commercially managed hostels.

AFTER ADMISSION:


7. **Printed leaflet** to be given to every fresher detailing addresses and telephone numbers of the Anti-Ragging Helpline, Wardens, Head of the institution, all members of the anti-ragging squads and committees, and relevant district and police authorities.

8. Identity of **informants** of ragging incidents to be fully protected.

9. Faculty members assigned to students to make **surprise visits** and to maintain a diary of his/her interaction with the freshers.

10. Freshers to be lodged, as far as may be, in a **separate hostel block**.

11. Head of the institution, at the end of each academic year, to send a letter to the parents/guardians of the students who are completing their first year in the institution informing them about these Regulations.

ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE and ANTI-RAGGING SQUAD

12. Anti-Ragging Committee to be nominated and headed by the Head of the institution, and consisting of representatives of **civil and police administration**, local media, Non Government Organizations involved in youth activities, representatives of faculty members, representatives of parents, representatives of students belonging to the **freshers'** category etc.

13. Duty of the Anti-Ragging Committee to ensure compliance with the provisions of these Regulations

14 Anti-Ragging Squad to be nominated by the Head of the Institution for maintaining vigil, oversight and **patrolling** functions and shall remain mobile, alert and active at all times.

15. Anti-Ragging Squad to make **surprise raids** on hostels.

16. Discreet random surveys to be conducted amongst the freshers every fortnight during the first three months.

17. The Heads of institutions affiliated to a University or a constituent of the University to submit a **weekly report** on the status of compliance with Anti-Ragging measures and a monthly report on such status thereafter, to the Vice-Chancellor of the University.

18. The Vice-Chancellor of each University to submit **fortnightly reports**, including those of the Monitoring Cell on Ragging in case of an affiliating university, to the State Level Monitoring Cell.

COMPLAINT OF RAGGING

19. **First Information Report (FIR)** to be filed within **twenty four hours** of receipt of such information or complaint of ragging, with the police and local authorities.

20. Head of the institution to forthwith report the incident of ragging to the District Level Anti-Ragging Committee and University .


21. Institution shall also continue with its own enquiry and remedial action to be completed with-in seven days.
