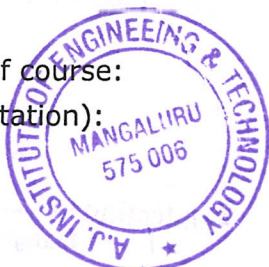

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## Maintenance requirements

You must have a minimum of £9207 (£1023 per month for 9 months) in living costs plus your tuition fee (minus deposit/scholarship/discount) for your first year of study.



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For example, if your tuition fee for your first year of study is £10500, your scholarship is £500 and you have paid a deposit of £4000, then your remaining tuition fee to show will be £6000. You must show £9207 (living costs) plus £6000 (tuition fees) which equals a total of £15207 in available funds.

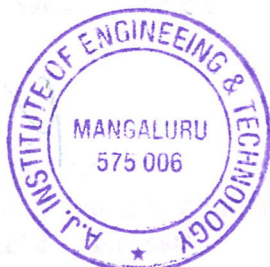
If you're from a country listed under the '[differential evidence requirement](#)', you do not need to provide your qualification or financial documents with your visa application, but UKVI may request them at any time whilst your application is being considered. Therefore, please have them readily available so that you can submit them immediately should UKVI request them.

## Important information about your Biometric Residence Permit (visa)

When you're granted your visa, you'll be issued with a vignette (visa sticker in your passport) with a validity of 30 days, to enable you to travel to the UK. You'll be required to collect your Biometric Residence Permit (BRP), within **10 days of your arrival to the UK**.

We are pleased to advise that **Anglia Ruskin University has been allocated as an 'Alternative Collection Location' (ACL)** for your BRP. By choosing ARU as your Alternative Collection Location when applying for your visa, you can collect your BRP from us when you arrive and register on campus. Simply enter the ACL code shown below when making your visa application to ensure your BRP is sent to ARU.

**Your Alternative Collection Location (ACL) is Chelmsford and your ACL code is 2HE569.**



ARU strongly encourages students to apply for their Dependents using the collection point at the Post Office, and not our Alternative Collection Location.

Please log onto the CAS Shield portal and complete the Pre-Departure and Travel Information. This includes providing a copy of your vignette, your intended date of arrival to the UK and accommodation arrangements.

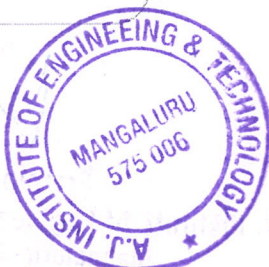

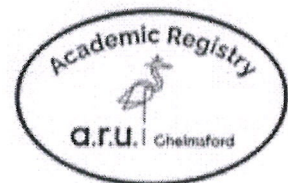
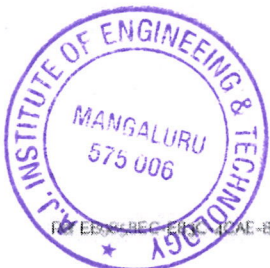
