**Sub : Appointment-Probation**

**1. SALARY AND PERQUISITES**

Your Total Target Compensation Structure (TTCS) per month will be Rs. 25,000/- as per Annexure.

The monthly / annual allowances, reimbursements, benefits and perquisites applicable to you are described in the annexure to this letter. Detailed policies / procedures/ rules and regulations governing the monthly / annual allowances, reimbursements, benefits and perquisites will be given to you after you join us.

**2. CODE OF CONDUCT.**

Throughout the years, iWave employees have set the standard for ethical business conduct. As part of your employment, you will be given a personal copy of our Code of Conduct. It outlines many of the details that pertain to standard of business behaviour that we expect all employees to live by. It is important for you to fully understand this philosophy and the policies and procedures governing it.

**3. PROBATION AND CONFIRMATION.**

You will be on probation for a period of one year from the date of appointment. Notice period for resignation or termination is three months on either side or basic salary in lieu thereof. The Company may, at its absolute discretion, waive the notice period that is required to be given by you.
